

SUCCESS STORY – CHHORM SREYRATH



Sreyrath is one of two children from Tropang Thom whose father raised them on the meagre income provided by dry season work in the salt fields. Assisted with a scholarship from CLS which provided her school supplies and uniforms, she attended Chumkriel State School from 2009 to 2014. She also attended English classes at the CLS Evening School.

On completion of her schooling she secured work at a medical clinic in Kampot. She worked there for a year before taking a position as a teacher's assistant at the Vattanak Vichea Private School in Kampot.

At the end of 2016, Sreyrath commenced a four-year course in English at a university in Kampot. Her ambition is to complete this course successfully and become an English teacher.

Once she has completed her studies, Sreyrath will have come a long way from life on the fringes of the salt fields. Her future promises a career in teaching which will allow her to improve the lives of further generations of Khmer children.
