

SUCCESS STORY – KEAT KIMYAN



After finishing high school, Kimyan was admitted to a four-year nursing course at Kampot Regional Training Centre for Health. She is studying there to be a nurse and should graduate in 2018.

From a broken family, Kimyan was raised by her mother who worked in the salt fields and, in the wet season, secured occasional work in the rice fields.

Due to this background of hardship, Kimyan received a scholarship from CLS in 2008. Over the following seven years this scholarship paid for her uniforms and school supplies, allowing her to attend Chumkriel State School and the CLS Evening School.

On completion of her present nursing course, Kimyan will be eligible for a career with either the Government or the private system.

With assistance from CLS, Kimyan has launched herself towards a professional career. It is a career which will be of considerable benefit to her fellow Khmer, allowing her to give back to the community from which she has come and to those who supported her.
