

SUCCESS STORY– MOEUNG CHANPHEAKDEY



About 3km from Chumkriel school lies Tropang Village. This is the home of Chanpheakdey who, after starting at Chumkriel State School, now works in Angkor Chey District with Kredit Micro Finance. This is a bank which provides loans to Khmer farmers and small businesses.

From a family of four children, Chanpheakdey attended Chumkriel State School from 2002 to 2008, finishing in Grade 9. She then moved to a high school in Kampot where she completed her schooling in 2011.

Awarded a scholarship by CLS in 2012 to attend University, Chanpheakdey studied Business Management for four years. During her high school and university years she also attended CLS Evening School, studying English for seven years. She saw this extra work as important to securing the future she wanted.

While studying at university, Chanpheakdey spent two years working for Project Indochina. This was an NGO with links to CLS that provided health services for poor families in and around Chumkriel.

Chanpheakdey is an example of a committed and persistent young woman who has profited from her own determination and the support of her community and CLS to embark on a promising professional career.
