Repairing and Improving

While COVID disrupted with classes, maintenance and improvement works continued:

- We replaced decayed thatch over storage areas by the garden with a fibro roof. This will last longer and need less maintenance.
- Tin guttering around the school has been replaced with PVC which won't rust and will last longer. Water collected goes to tanks and is used for washing and drinking.
- Stairs to the pond make it easier and safer for our garden staff to access stored water as the level drops.
- Equipment at the salt field playground, worn by years of use, was repaired.
- A concrete apron by the salt field school offers a safe and clean surface in place of mud in the wet and ruts and dust in the dry.
- Engine maintenance and essential repairs were carried out on the salt field truck, including cutting out rust and painting repaired panels.
